

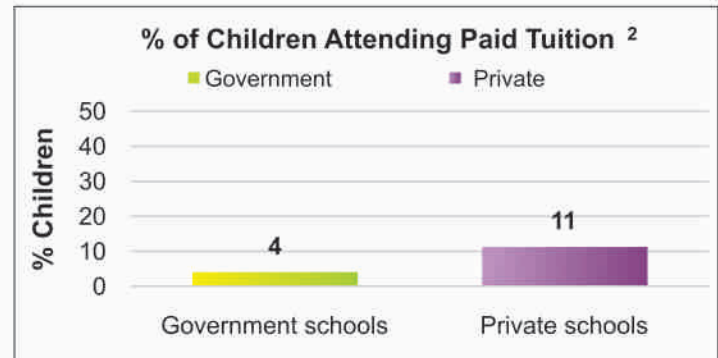

56% men and 38% women aged 10 years and older are literate in Bahawalpur. Overall, the district is ranked **30** among 37 districts on literacy indicator.<sup>1</sup>

### Enrollment

- **Children in the 3-5 age group:** 47% are enrolled (43% girls and 57% boys). Of this percentage, 50% children are enrolled in government schools and 50% in private educational facilities.<sup>2</sup>
- **Children in the 6-16 age group:** 80% are enrolled (40% girls and 60% boys). Of this percentage, 61% children are enrolled in government schools and 39% in private educational facilities.<sup>2</sup>
- **Out-of-school children:** 20% children (6-16 years) are not attending any school. Out of this number, 50% are girls and 50% boys.<sup>2</sup>

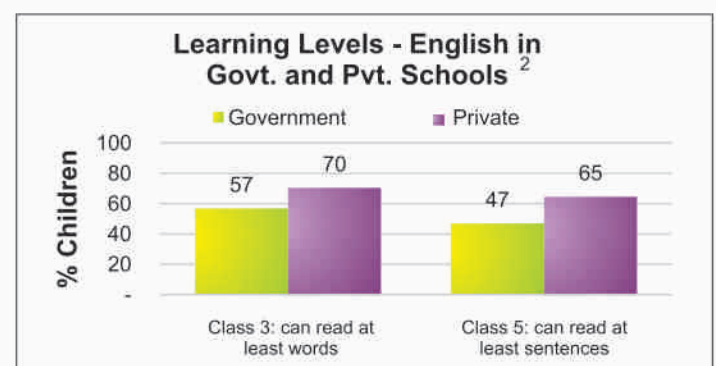
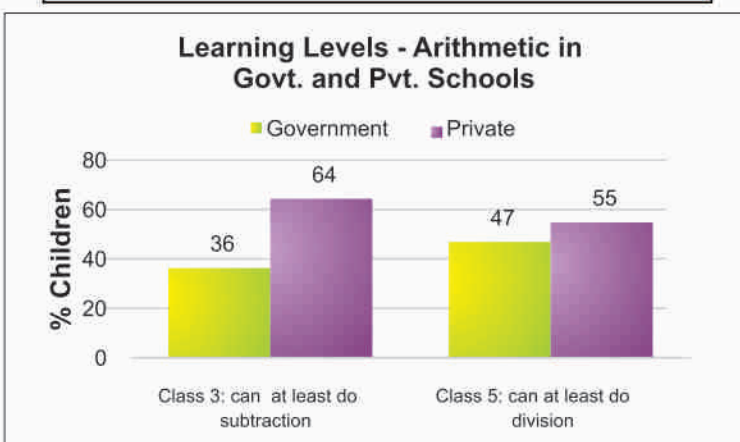
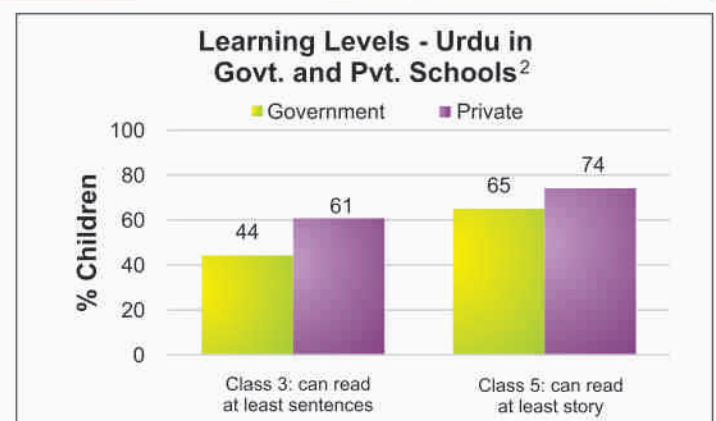


Enrollment drops as significantly at middle, high and higher secondary level class

### Learning Levels (Rural)<sup>2</sup>

- 44% of class 3 students in government schools and 61% in private schools are able to read sentences in **Urdu**
- 36% of class 3 students in government schools and 64% in private schools are able to do simple **subtraction**
- 57% of class 3 students in government schools and 70% in private schools are able to read words in **English**

**Mother Literacy:** 65% illiterate and 35% literate
