Enrollment

- **Children in the 3-5 age group:** 56% are enrolled (36% girls and 64% boys). Of this percentage, 41% children are enrolled in government schools and 59% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Children in the 6-16 age group:** 90% are enrolled (31% girls and 69% boys). Of this percentage, 63% children are enrolled in government schools and 37% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Out-of-school children:** 10% children (6-16 years) are not attending any school. Out of this number, 57% are girls and 43% boys.⁴

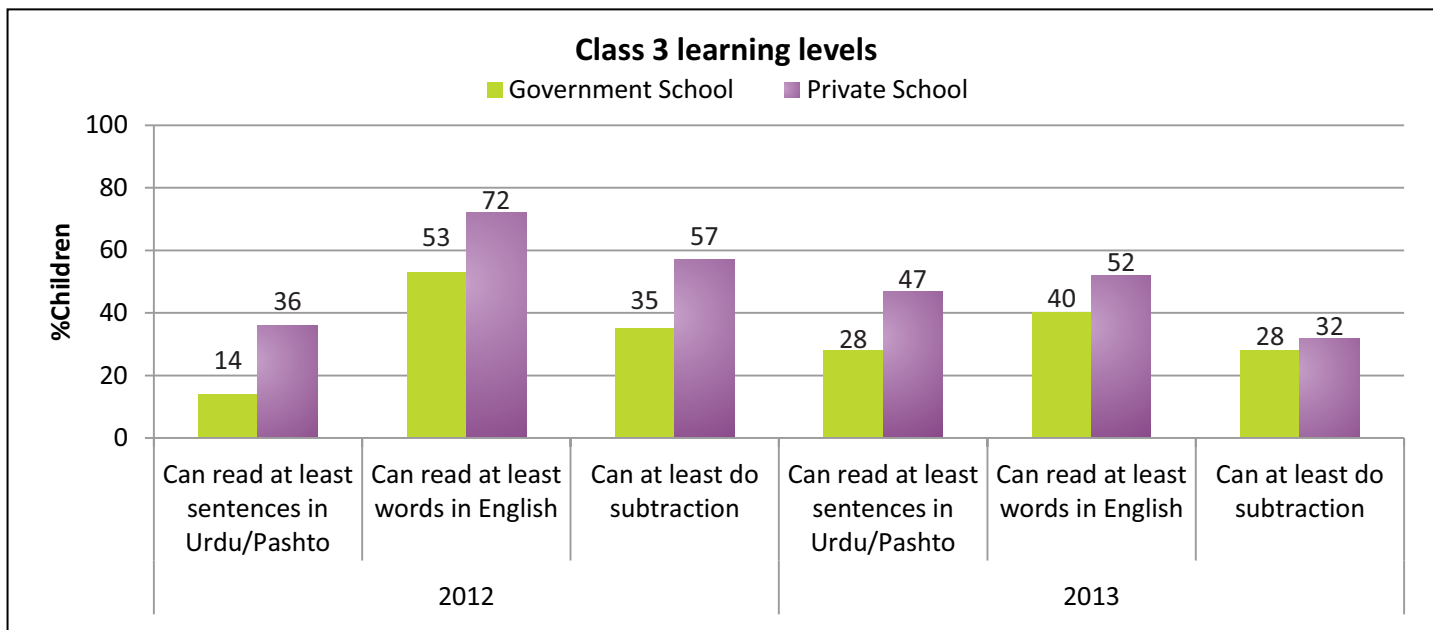

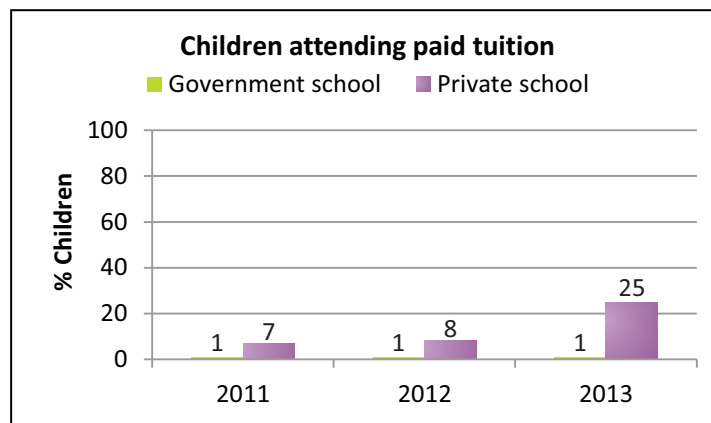
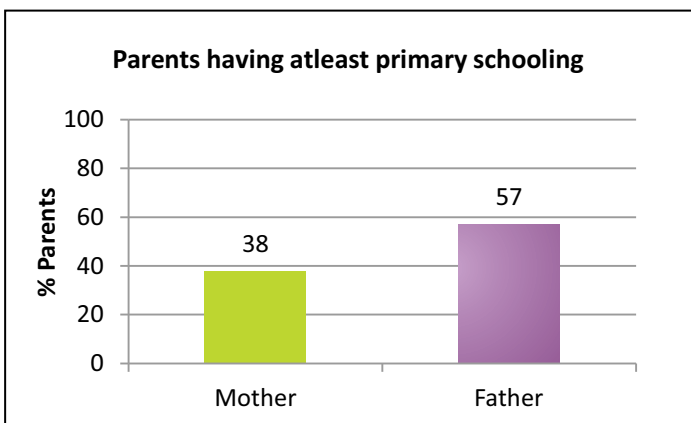


Learning Levels (Rural)⁴

- 28% of class 3 students in government and 47% in private schools are able to read sentences in **Urdu/Pashto** as compared to 14% in government and 36% in private schools in 2012.
- 40% of class 3 students in government and 52% in private schools are able to read words in **English** as compared to 53% in government and 72% in private schools in 2012.
- 28% of class 3 students in government and 32% in private schools are able to do simple **Subtraction** as compared to 35% in government and 57% in private schools in 2012.
