Enrollment

- **Children in the 3-5 age group:** 42% are enrolled (46% girls and 54% boys). Of this percentage, 60% children are enrolled in government schools and 40% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Children in the 6-16 age group:** 91% are enrolled (38% girls and 62% boys). Of this percentage, 73% children are enrolled in government schools and 27% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Out-of-school children:** 9% children (6-16 years) are not attending any school. Out of this number, 60% are girls and 40% boys.⁴

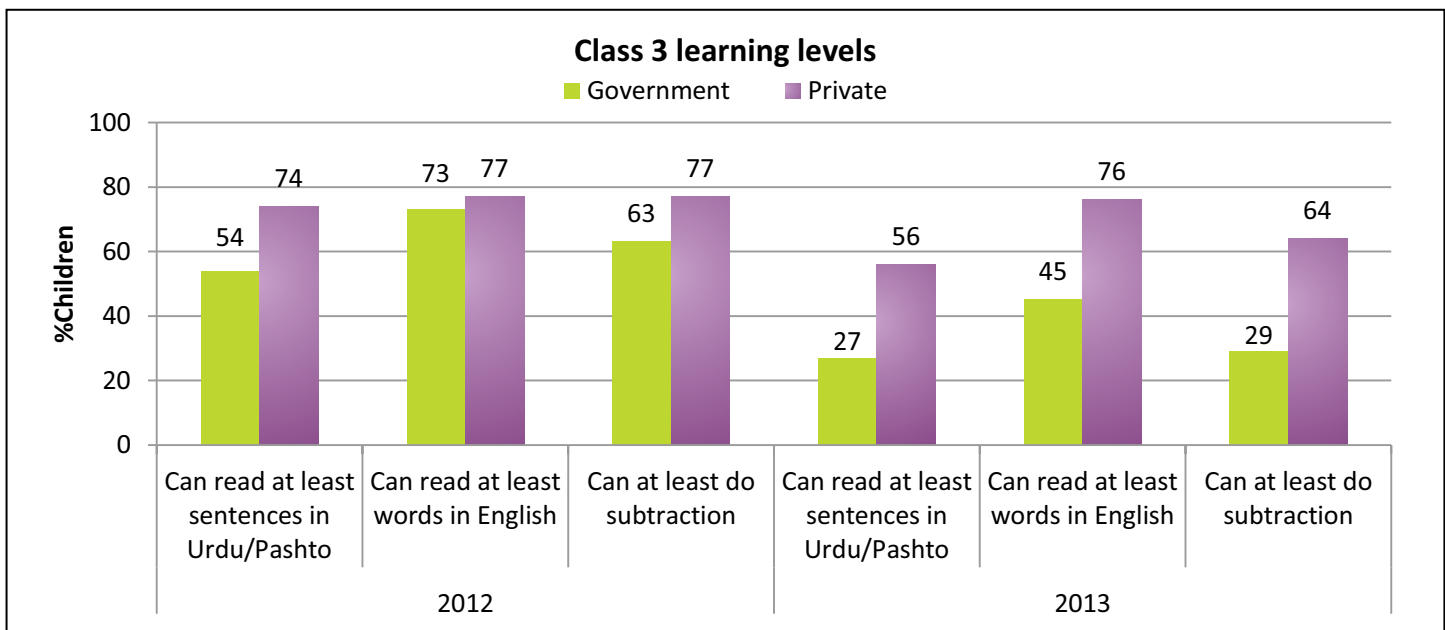

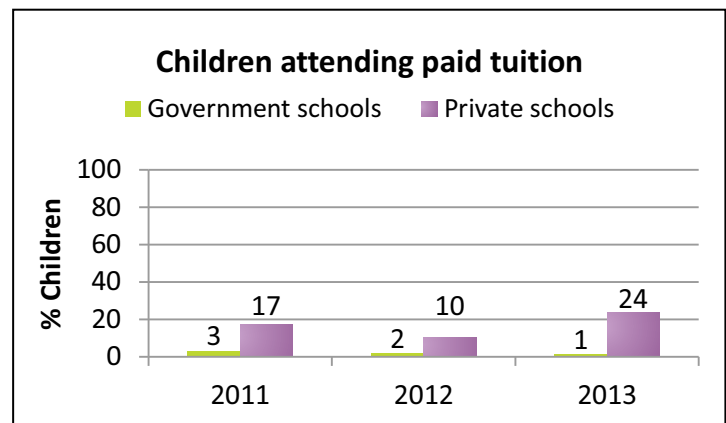
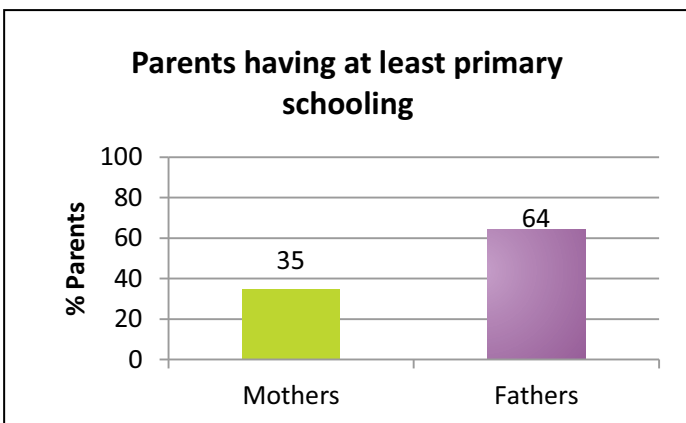


Learning Levels (Rural)⁴

- 27% of class 3 students in government and 56% in private schools are able to read sentences in **Urdu/Pashto** as compared to 54% in government and 74% in private schools in 2012.
- 45% of class 3 students in government and 76% in private schools are able to read words in **English** as compared to 73% in government and 77% in private schools in 2012.
- 29% of class 3 students in government and 64% in private schools are able to do simple **Subtraction** as compared to 63% in government and 77% in private schools in 2012.
