Enrollment

- **Children in the 3-5 age group:** 50% are enrolled (43% girls and 57% boys). Of this percentage, 68% children are enrolled in government schools and 32% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Children in the 6-16 age group:** 73% are enrolled (37% girls and 63% boys). Of this percentage, 80% children are enrolled in government schools and 20% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Out-of-school children:** 27% children (6-16 years) are not attending any school. Out of this number, 60% are girls and 40% boys.⁴

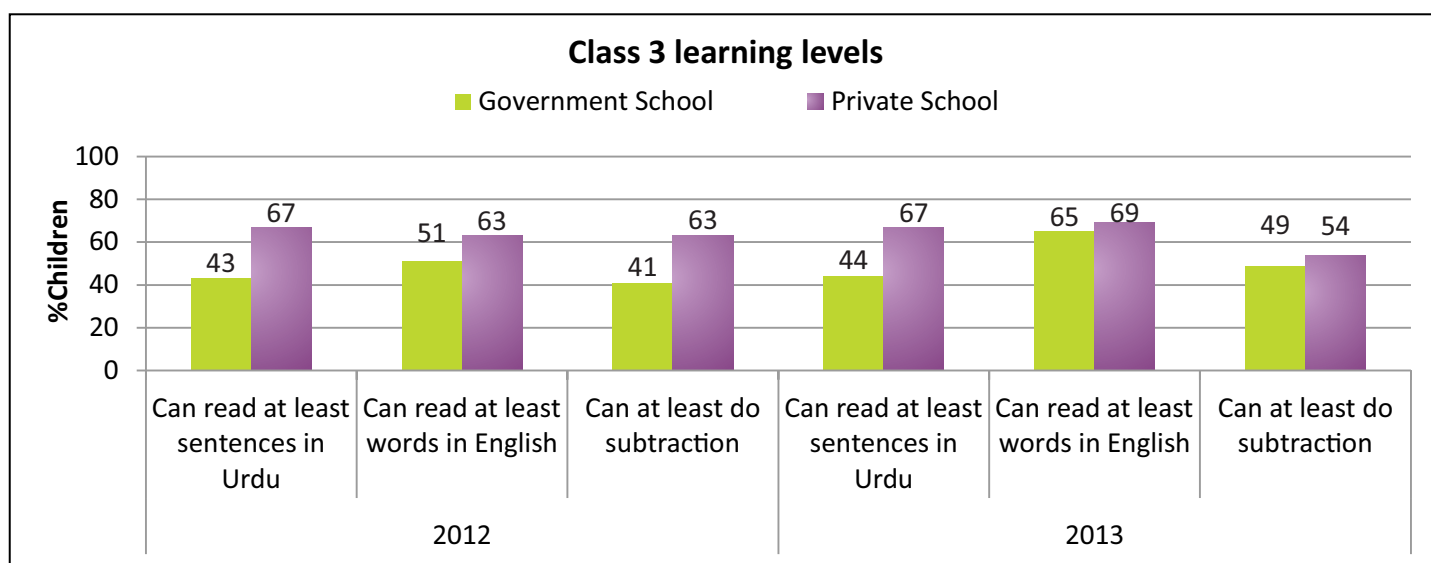

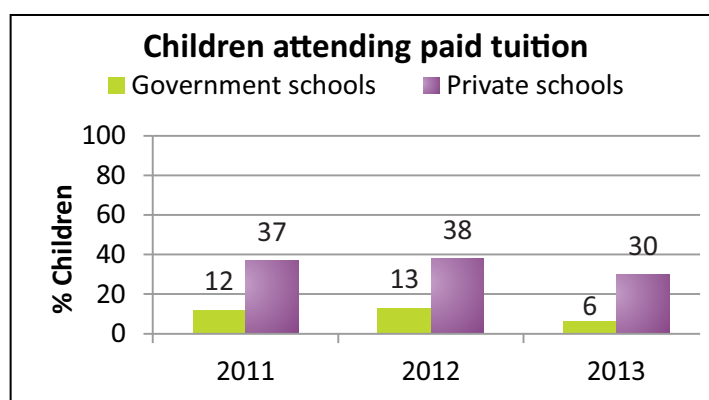
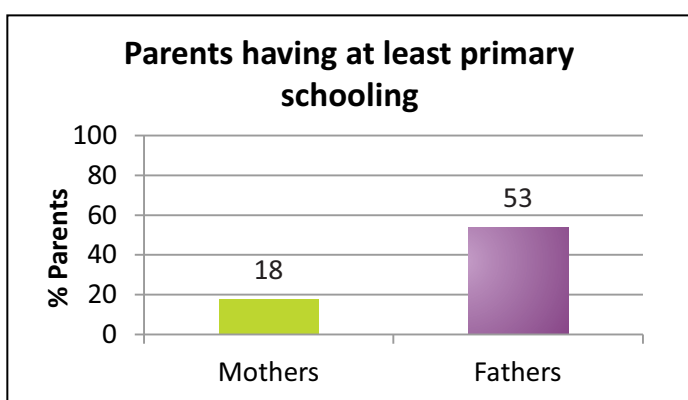


Learning Levels (Rural)⁴

- 44% of class 3 students in government and 67% in private schools are able to read sentences in **Urdu** as compared to 43% in government and 67% in private schools in 2012.
- 65% of class 3 students in government and 69% in private schools are able to read words in **English** as compared to 51% in government and 63% in private schools in 2012.
- 49% of class 3 students in government and 54% in private schools are able to do simple **Subtraction** as compared to 41% in government and 63% in private schools in 2012.
