Enrollment

- **Children in the 3-5 age group:** 51% are enrolled (45% girls and 55% boys) in schools. Of this percentage, 68% children are enrolled in government schools and 32% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Children in the 6-16 age group:** 84% are enrolled (36% girls and 64% boys) in schools. Of this percentage, 70% children are enrolled in government schools and 30% in private educational facilities.⁴
- **Out-of-school children:** 16% children (6-16 years) are not attending any school. Out of this number, 59% are girls and 41% boys.⁴

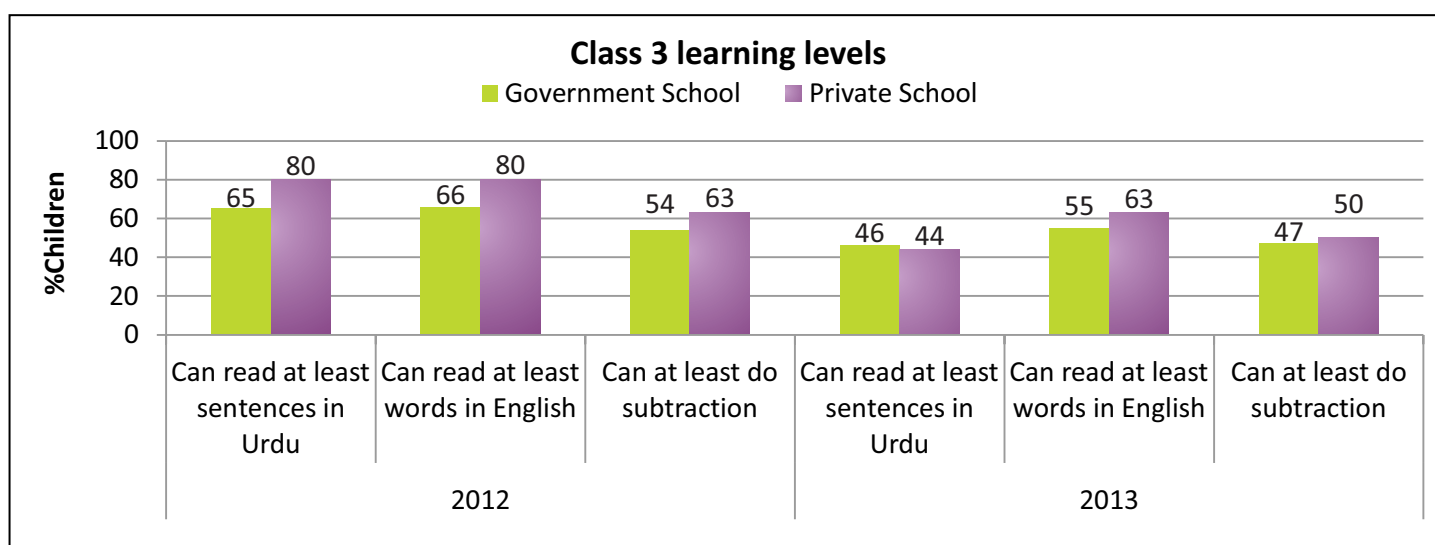

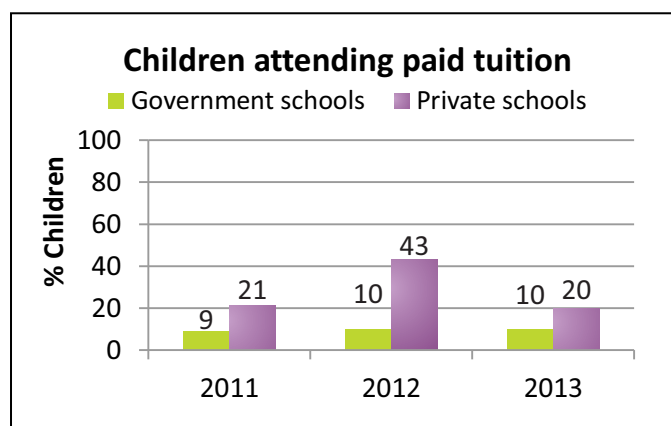
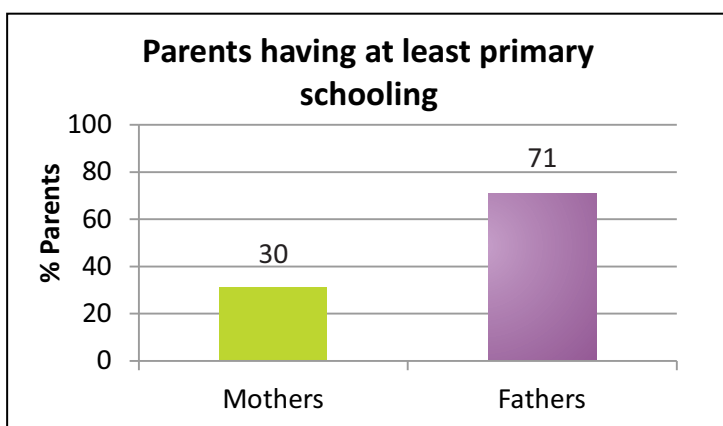


Learning Levels (Rural)⁴

- 46% of class 3 students in government and 44% in private schools are able to read sentences in **Urdu** as compared to 65% in government and 80% in private schools in 2012.
- 55% of class 3 students in government and 63% in private schools are able to read words in **English** as compared to 66% in government and 80% in private schools in 2012.
- 47% of class 3 students in government and 50% in private schools are able to do simple **Subtraction** as compared to 54% in government and 63% in private schools in 2012.
