ASER Pakistan 2011 covered 143,826 children aged 3-16 years; the overall enrollment rate is nearly 80% where as 20% children are out of school. The situation in Balochistan, FATA and Sindh is alarming where 24%, 25% and 30% children are out of school respectively. 16% & 15% children are out of school in Punjab and Khyber – Pakhtunkhwa respectively whereas situation is relatively better in AJK where 10% children are out of school respectively.
