

3 Facts about enrollment


- 1 out of 5 children (aged 6-16 years) are out of school in Pakistan.



- 1 out of 2 children in class 5 cannot read class 2 story text.


How to read: 8.2% (4.5+3.7) children of class 1 can read sentences


- 4 out of 5 children in class 3 cannot read sentences in English

How to read: 13.9% (10.2+3.7) children of class 1 can read words







% Children who can do division (Arithmetic)






