





# LEARNING LEVELS (By Gender) 🥏 (5-16 Years)






#### **INFORMATION & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY**


- 78% of households across all rural districts of Pakistan have mobile phones.

#### **ALTERNATE ENERGY**


· Across all rural districts of Pakistan, 18% of the sampled households use solar panels as an alternate energy resource.


