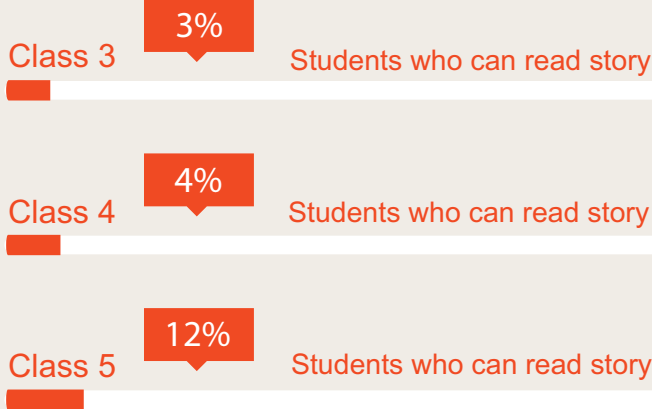
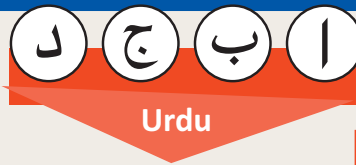


Out of school children by gender 6 to 16 years

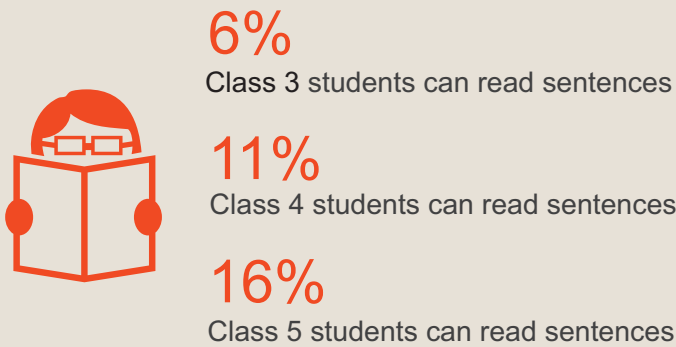
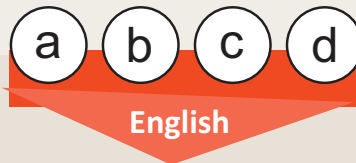
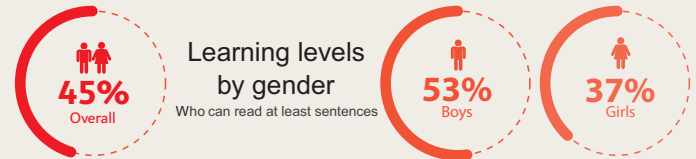
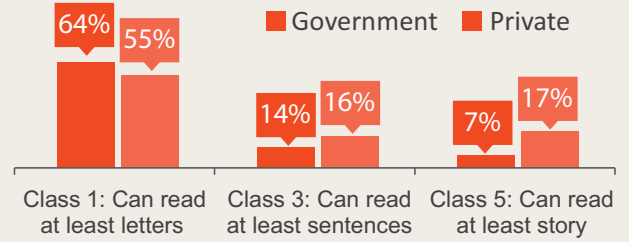

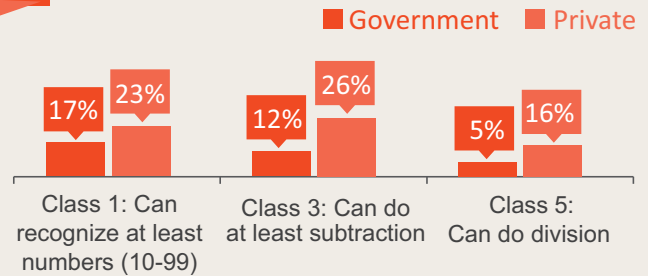
Learning levels by school type
