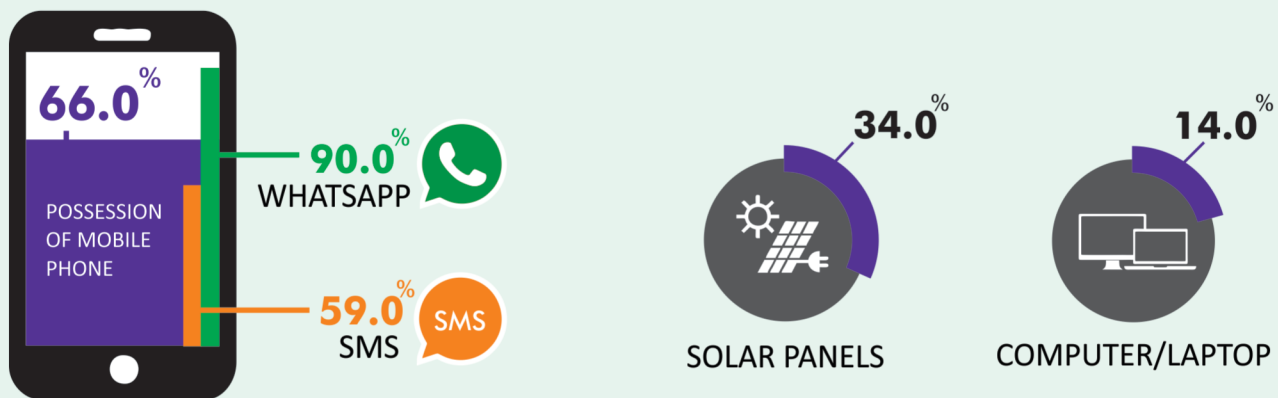
INFORMATION & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY

- **66%** of households across all rural districts of Pakistan have mobile phones.
- Amongst mobile users, **90%** use Whatsapp service for communication.
- Amongst mobile users, **59%** use SMS facility for communication.
- **14%** of households have computers/laptops

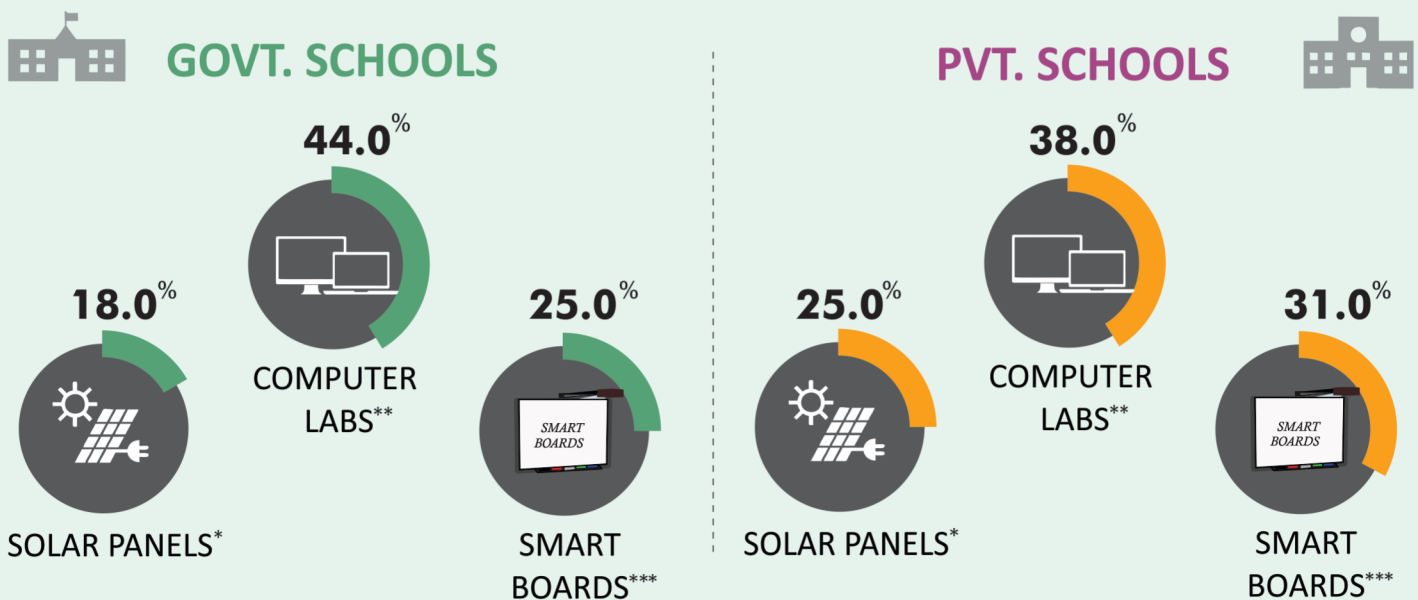
ALTERNATE ENERGY
